### 1 Bart Stuyf 16 Mussel Point Way, Gloucester

This year, Bart's seaside studio has inspired many new ocean based themes. His sculptures of fish among the coral, octopi, shrimp and sea anemones can be seen swimming under the watchful eye of sea birds..

Take Route 128 N to exit 15, turn right on School Street toward Manchester. Turn left onto Route 127/Summer Street, drive 4.6 miles, then right on Hesperus Avenue for 1/10 mile. Turn left on Mussel Point Road, after 1/10 mile turn right on Mussel Point Way (dirt road). #16 is first house on the left.

Return to Mussel Point Road and turn left. At end, turn right onto Hesperus Avenue. Drive to end, turn right on Route 127; drive one mile, turn left onto Bond Street. #38 Bond Street is on left.

Step through the iron gate and into the charming brick courtyard to discover this jewel of a glass studio nestled within. Immediately you are surrounded by color, light and the texture of Beth's handmade glass beads and jewelry, made in the Venetian flame working tradition—with a contemporary flair. It's all about the color!

From Bond Street, left onto 127, go .3 miles over drawbridge and past Statue. Go up hill, right at intersection, left on Rogers Street. After Walgreens Plaza, left on Manuel F Lewis Road, left on Main. Go two blocks, turn right on Pleasant. Studio is one block on right behind iron gates, parking across the street.

From Pleasant go south past Middle. Cross Main Street to Duncan. Left on Rogers to traffic lights. Turn right onto East Main Street. 97 E. Main is on right at Cripple Cove Studios.

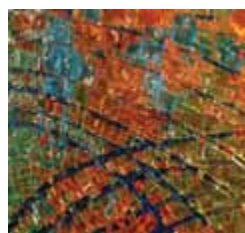


Scott Place and Erin O'Sullivan create functional pottery inspired by the beauty of Cape Ann. Classes for children and adults are offered year round.

Take East Main back to Sayward Street. At stop sign go straight on Bass Ave. Left on Thatcher Road after Stop&Shop plaza. Continue onto South Street 3.8 miles. Twin Lights Studio on left.

From Twin Lights turn left on South Street. Drive .05 miles, turn left on Prospect Street. #16A is on right. Park in driveway with brick building or on street.

Stop by Cynthia's beautiful studio nestled among the quarries to view her popular ocean-inspired pottery, some with melted beach glass. Come take a class and see what all the fun is about!

Take Prospect back to Mt. Pleasant, turn left. At Dock Square bear left onto Main Street. Turn right on Beach Street, drive to end. Right onto Granite Street/Route 127 to Pigeon Cove. After Pigeon Cove Post Office, turn left on Curtis Street, then first left on Pigeon Hill Street. Follow signs for Paper House, continue to top of hill.

From Sara Wright's studio continue on Stockholm Avenue to Curtis Street, turn left. Continue .2 mile, then turn left on Route 127. Drive 1.1 miles, turn left on Woodbury Street. #9 is on the right, go in the driveway.

Turn around on Langsford Street, drive .2 miles and turn right onto Ship's Bell Road.

Return to Route 127/Langsford Street, turn right. As Route 127 curves sharply to left, turn right onto Andrews Street. Next right on Sunset Pt. Road. Go to end and turn left onto dirt drive. Park at signs and go through gate.

From #14, go back down Tucker Street, left on Washington; 2nd left onto High Street, park on High, studio is in on the right.

Continue on Washington Street. Take second left on Dennison Street just before the Stone bridge. At fork take sharp right onto Holly Street. Continue over the hill to #70 at bottom right. Park in front slots. Studio is at the rear.

Continue south on Washington Street, drive .7 miles, turn right on Ferry Street just before hospital. Go .3 miles, turn right at Montgomery Boatyard / River Boatworks sign, drive through boat yard to studio.
